

About Us

Encina Wastewater Authority (EWA) is a wastewater treatment agency in Carlsbad, California. We serve over 400,000 residents and regulate approximately 600 business in a 125-squaremile service area in northwest San Diego County. Six public agencies own EWA through a Joint Powers Agreement that facilitates cost sharing and enables economies of scale that the individual member agencies could not achieve independently. These member agencies are the City of Carlsbad, the City of Vista, the City of Encinitas, the Vallecitos Water District, the Buena Sanitation District, and the Leucadia Wastewater District.

About Carlsbad

Carlsbad is a seaside community of 39 square miles, nearly 40% of which is dedicated to open space. Due to our perfect climate, you can enjoy 46 trails, 40 parks, 3 pristine lagoons, and nearly 7 miles of beaches year-round. Temperatures range from an average of 58 degrees in January to 73 degrees in July, making every day a beach day. In addition to great surfing/swimming/fishing opportunities, Carlsbad is home to several world-famous golf courses, LegoLand, The Flower Fields, and a charming Village that's perfect for an afternoon stroll or evening out.

The Opportunity

EWA is currently seeking an experienced Electrical Instrumentation Specialist (EIS) to join our Technical Services Department.

As an EIS, you will: inspect, test, program, service, troubleshoot, and complete preventative maintenance tasks on EWA electrical and instrumentation equipment, process controls, and monitoring equipment; maintain various electrical, pneumatic and electronic controls, alarm and telemetry systems, programmable controllers, and related equipment; prepare purchase orders for parts and materials; contact vendors for pricing of specialized parts and services, and oversee and inspect work performed by outside vendors; assist in budget preparation; maintain accurate documentation of parts and materials withdrawn from inventory; operate forklifts, utility carts, and other such equipemnt as required within the plant compound.

The Ideal Candidate

This position requires graduation from high school or equivalent plus three years of experience in a similar role. Training in electrical troubleshooting and repair and other specialty coursework is desired but not required. Possession of a CWEA Grade III Electrical/Instrumentation Specialist Certification is highly desirable but not required.

Possession of a non-restricted California Driver's License and successful completion of a pre-employment physical examination, drug screen, and background checks will be required at the time of appointment.

Compensation

The salary range for this position is \$34.03 - \$45.94, depending on experience and certifications.
